- 466 EMMC graduates (2004-20112) [Erasmus Mundus Action 1]
- 19 EMMD graduates (2009-2012) [Erasmus Mundus Action 1]
- 80 scholars (2004-2012) [Erasmus Mundus Action 1]

Total: ~3,770

- 400 EM Partnership, 2 consortia 2013 (deadline 15 April 2013) [Expected mobility as a result of the award of 2 consortia Erasmus Mundus Partnership]
- 75 EMMC+EMMD, 2013 [students expected to obtain Erasmus Mundus Master's scholarship and PhD fellowships in 2013]
